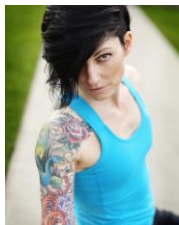

Rigging Options and Technical Requirements

Rigging Option #1 – Rigging into an Existing Structure:

Truss System

- Voler harnesses and carabiners will be used to secure aerial points
- Static: Ladders, boom lift or basket crane will be required for rigging
- Dynamic: Rigging can take place from ground and lifted by system

Beam or Vault System

- Voler harnesses and carabiners will be used to secure aerial points
- Ladders, boom lift or basket crane will be required for rigging
- 1” Eyebolt installation may be necessary if there is no space to wrap harnesses

Rigging Option #2 – Loading-In Free-Standing Rigging (as contracted for use with Voler):

- Installation by Voler
- Single aerial point
- 22” feet tall
- 25’x25’ Floor Span Required

Rigging Requirements

Note: Points can be rigged by Voler Non-Union Riggers per contract or through Venue Union Rigger for an additional fee. Load capability is based on dynamic movement, aerial apparatus weight and performer(s) weight.

Silk Rigging Point*

- 10’-30’ high
- 1000-1500lbs load
- 10’ radius clearance
- 1-2 aerialists

Lyra (Hoop) Rigging Point*

- 10’-13’ high
- 1000-1500lbs. load
- 10’ radius clearance
- 1-2 aerialists

Diamond Rigging Point*

- 10’-13’ high
- 1000lbs load
- 10’ radius clearance
- 1 aerialist

Silk Hammock Rigging Point*

- 10’-18’ high
- 1000-1500lbs load
- 10’ radius clearance
- 1-2 aerialists

Strap Rigging Point*

- 10’-15’ high
- 1000-1500lbs load
- 10’ radius clearance
- 1-2 aerialists

Net Hammock Rigging Point*

- 10’-18’ high
- 1000-1500lbs load
- 10’ radius clearance
- 1-2 aerialists

Carousel Rigging Point

- 12’-30’ high
- 2000-4000lbs load
- 15’ radius clearance
- 2-6 aerialists

Corde Lisse (Rope) Rigging Point

- 18’-20’ high
- 1000 lbs. load
- 15’ radius clearance
- 1 aerialist

** Aerial Rigging Points listed are static points however a flying/pulley point can be rigged for these apparatuses. (Additional tech persons and equipment may be required).*

Voler Performance Requirements

- Rehearsal in venue prior to performance
- Dressing room area
- Water in dressing room

- Promotional materials on display, in gift bags or program mention (whichever best applies)
- Two Voler Techs allowed into event with access to backstage with Voler performers
- Copies of event photos or video (or Voler photographer/videographer allowed to document)
